Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any educational institution and we meticulously follow the CBSE pattern of syllabus and assessments. Skill development in all subjects is a main focus and activities are planned accordingly. Practical lab classes are given from class 6 to 10 once a week for all science subjects and mathematics including the HEYMATH programme which supports online help in solving problems. Speaking and listening activities are given for the languages and project work in social studies. The SCHOOL CINEMA is a collaborative programme for imparting value education for the students using audio visual facilities.

Apart from academics we have a large number of functions and celebrations marked with total student involvement.

#### **CELEBRATIONS**

# EXTRA CURRICULAR AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

At Honey Bunch we believe that extracurricular activities greatly enrich the school experience of our students. To list the special activities provided in the school we have

- Training of scouts and guides is given so that students are trained to write the exams for the Rajya Puraskar award and the Rashtrapathi awards after a few years.

# EXTRA CURRICULAR

- Classical music is offered to the whole school once a week to inculcate the traditional methods of music and thereby also bring in good thoughts and discipline in the students.

- Karate is again offered to both boys and girls and this is a form of martial arts used for self defence.
- Yoga, a form of meditation is the need of the hour for the students to overcome the stress and temptations that arise during their day to day activities.

# WORK EDUCATION

- The signature identity of CBSE Board is the work education activity which is also called socially useful productive work which helps the students do their daily chores which will continue for their lifetime.
- The school provides gardening as an activity which inculcates good crop growing process by using organic manure. Our students grow vegetables in the school garden and once grown they cook it by themselves in the school campus.
- Knitting is a skill in making woollen products which can even be a small scale business that can provide tremendous scope in the marketing industry.
- Meal planning and cookery instils a sense of nutritious cooking and eating and prepares them for the art of healthy cooking.

Electrical gadgets and repairs is again a life skill training which will instill in the students an interest towards engineering.

#### TRAINING AND WORKSHOPS

The CBSE believes in getting its teachers trained as in service training programme and workshops, to enhance their teaching skills. The Management of Honey Bunch School is always willing to send its teachers for CBSE trainings and also arranges for training inside the school bringing in eminent resource people, subject wise and also for study skills.

#### STUDENT WORKSHOPS

Students need to be constantly guided in their learning process and so, subject experts visit our school at regular intervals to enhance the subject knowledge and train the students to face the challenges of the examination.

- The Teachers collective from Bangalore conducted a training for students of classes 6 to 10 on July 12,13 and also for teachers on the enhancing of the study skills. The students were taught note making, note taking, highlighting which tremendously helped them to increase their scores .The higher classes were taught time management and stress free learning. The teachers were guided to handle situations in the classroom with a lot number of mindfulness activities.
- Reading programme for primary classes 1to5 was initiated and teachers were trained to conduct the reading programme which uses International standards implementing DAILY FIVE AND CAFE developed through use in US classrooms. It is a yearlong programme with goals that will be in place, age appropriately will be accuracy, fluency of reading, comprehension and vocabulary development. An intensive training in workshop mode will be conducted to prepare teachers to implement this programme in their classrooms.
- Mrs.Vijayalakshmi Srivatsan, an expert in classroom pedagogy conducted a one day training for teachers and students for the higher classes to mainly focus on the teaching programmes for the Board exam batches and how to face the examination.

- The parents of each class can be called separately for the orientation programme so that the school can enlighten on the CBSE proceedings and the year plan of the school. The primary classes must be trained in such a way that the students have to be strong in the fundamentals.
- Motivational speakers can be called to orient the parents on the study skills and the Career guidance courses.
- During the vacations ,the students may be given short term courses on maintaining bicycles, two wheelers, cleaning the car, one day visit to the hospital or a shop so that they know how to serve people and to handle money.

- > Parents need to supervise the students and teach them to be independent.
- The SMC members appreciated the efforts taken by the students to prepare the school magazine.
- > A suggestion to start the school parliament and the school band was given
- Social service activities can be done in the Government schools by teaching them singing, dancing, drawing and by bringing them to the school for smart board classes.

# **Olympiad Examinations**

Olympiads enable the students to go through a complete scan of what and how much they learned. The tests are scientifically designed to test concepts underlying the curriculum in an interesting manner.

Olympiads aim at improvement rather than comparison or grading. It also reduces the stress of exams by checking "Understanding and Reasoning" rather than just "Knowing".

# SPORTS AND GAMES

Sports and games are a great way for students to develop skills, achieve goals and stay physically fit. we have allotted periods everyday for games activities, mass drill, exercises and yoga classes. Special coaching will be given for football, basketball, volleyball, kabbadi, kho-kho, table tennis, ball badminton, carrom and chess. Annual sports meet was held and various matches were conducted house wise.

Coming to a major part of curriculum, the area of sports, the school has seen good achievements.
