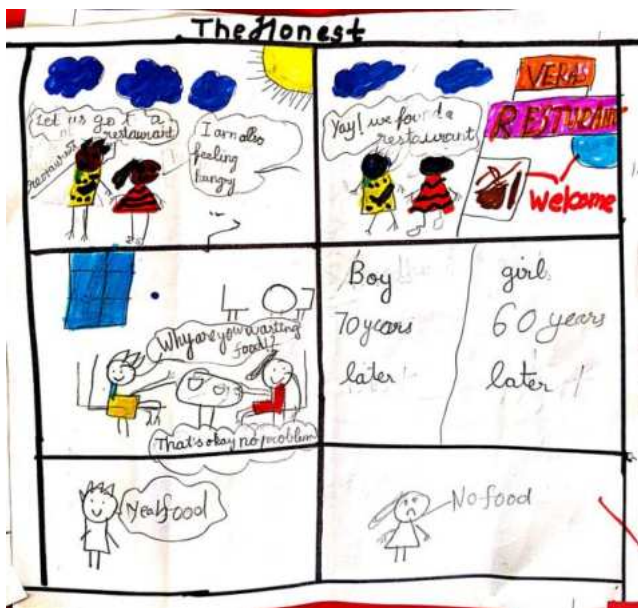

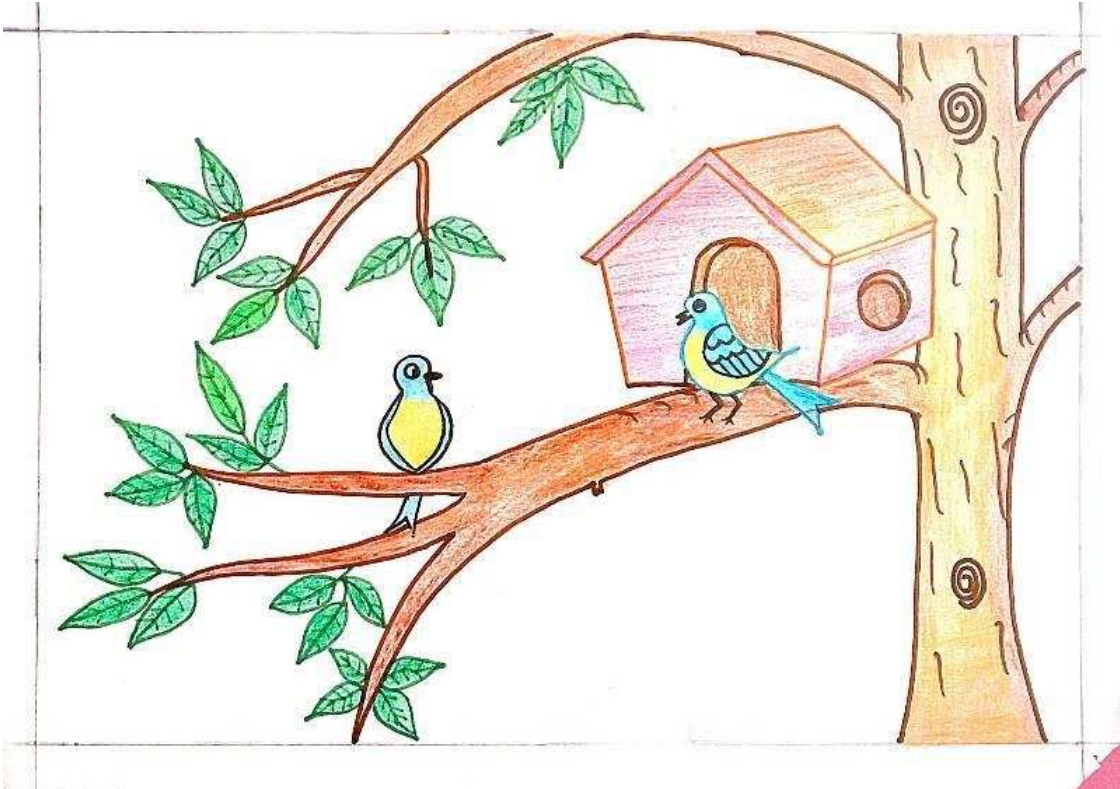

THE COOLEST INVENTION - AUTOMATIC TELESCOPE

The coolest invention I knew was the telescope which was used to stargaze at the night sky. Telescopes help us to view the astronomical wonders of the sky. These telescopes were used in the early 1600s by Galileo. He was the man who found the refractor type of Telescope. Using that he viewed the Saturn rings, Jupiter's Four Moons, and even more.... From that day Humans grew their curiosity towards Space Research. Then a new model of telescope was founded by Newton which was named the Newtonian Telescope or reflective telescope. There was an effect in the refractor model found by Galileo, which was the outer border of the stars and moon appeared with different colours,

Newton corrected the mistakes by keeping a mirror in the telescope. So, when the observer sees through the telescope the bouncing of lights removes the colours seen around the sky objects. Later new telescope was found called as Dobsonian telescope or Compound telescope. It had both features of the Newtonian and Galilean telescope. Later automatic telescopes were developed where the telescopes itself locate the stars and planets and give the best image quality. In olden times it was difficult for astronomers to locate the direction of certain stars. Now with smart automatic telescopes using star sense technology is very easy to locate stars. This was found by Celestron and many more companies had these features developed. Using the motor Drive option now the telescope itself can track the path of the Milky Way galaxy and Nebulas. Now some telescopes have very powerful and long focal lengths and apertures which are used by astronomical organisations such as Hubble telescopes.

The telescope is made of two lens such as concave and Convex. One lens for the eyepiece another for absorbing more light inside it. We are making this so we can find planets and

other galaxies or star systems that have the habitable place where a life form can be found. The telescopes are now used as a protective measure to find out meteoroids or asteroids which are going to hit the earth and take necessary actions. The curiosity over space has never ended for humans. These devices help us and gives a closer look towards space observation. It is one of the coolest inventions I ever knew.

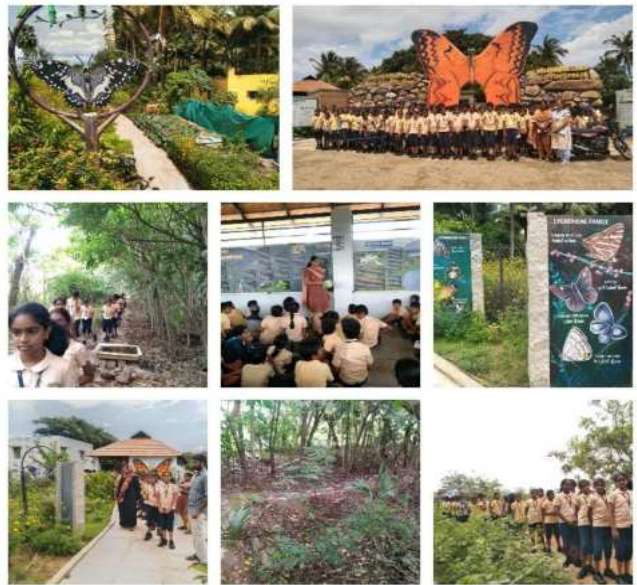
